



PLEASE BE REMINDED THAT:

*Only light foods are allowed as lunch for pupils in the school. Parents/Guardians should please take note that solid foods are not allowed.

*Birthday parties are celebrated in RIS with only cake and packet/plastic drinks. Party packs, snacks outside what has been specified above are not permitted for staff and pupils

*Pupils are allowed to bring cooked food to school; parents are implored to have their food in warmers that could keep the food warm till break time.

*Nursery pupils are not allowed to put beads in their hair, only ribbons are allowed.

*In the morning, pupils are to come in through the Decontamination Booth at the front gate.

*Late pick-up (From 4:31pm) attracts a penalty of N500.00 per family.

*Braids or use of attachment is not allowed. Girls should have their hair neatly plaited and boys' hair cropped.

*All children are dropped at the entrance of the walkway. The very little Nursery pupils are escorted to their classes by RIS Staff at the gate.
